A RESOLUTION MADE BY THE KAMAS CITY COUNCIL CANCELLING THE KAMAS CITY 2019 ELECTION FOR THREE CITY COUNCIL MEMEBERS

WHEREAS, according to Utah Code 20A-1-206 Kamas City desires to cancel the November 5, 2019 Municipal Election and certifies that the number of candidates does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices.

WHEREAS, Kamas City has three at-large Council seats open for election, with three applicants, Kamas City has no municipal ballot propositions, and Kamas City did not receive any write-in candidates.

THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the City Council of Kamas, Utah, as follows: The November 5, 2019 Municipal General Election is hereby cancelled. The Kamas City Council certifies that there are three candidates for the at-large City Council seats. The following candidates are considered to be elected to office, John F. Blazzard, Monica Blazzard and Kevan Todd for the three four-year City Council seats.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
